Dear authors, Congratulations on the manuscript. The addressed topic is quite relevant, given that research on community-acquired pneumonia (CAP) plays a fundamental role in the prevention, diagnosis, and effective treatment of the disease, contributing to the improvement of public health and the reduction of morbidity and mortality associated with CAP. I have a few considerations: 1. Keywords play a crucial role in the identification, indexing, and visibility of a scientific article, essential for enhancing its impact and reach within the academic and scientific community. Therefore, I suggest changing the keywords "Multidrug-resistant bacteria" and "Community-acquired pneumonia" as they seem not to reflect the focus of the manuscript. 2. Using updated references in a scientific article is crucial to ensuring the credibility, accuracy, and relevance of the work, as well as advancing knowledge within a specific field of study. Hence, I suggest seeking a more recent reference regarding reference number 4. 3. Lastly, upon reviewing the text, I noticed that reference number 14 is listed in the references but was not found in the body of the text. I hope that my suggestions and comments have been useful and contribute to further strengthening the quality and relevance of your



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work. Once again, congratulations on the excellent work, and I wish you success in your future research.
