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remarks - 1. The structure of the case details shouldn't be broken to small headlines, but should rather be written as a story in one piece. 2. The authors need to get rid of the patient details in the MRI figure enclosed, and I think further images, perhaps in the coronal view should be added. 3. I'm not sure all the histology figures should be included, some of them don't really add to the report. Other than that, I thank the authors for an enjoyable read.
