The patient underwent reconstructive surgery with anterolateral thigh and ilioinguinal flaps. After two repair operations, satisfactory results were obtained, including good fracture healing, good skin flap shape, and good wrist joint function. The case report was well written overall. This case study is believed to be of beneficial aid to the expansion of scientific knowledge. If the authors complete minor revisions, the quality of the study will be further improved.

2. The number of reference papers is 8, which is a small. If possible, authors are encouraged to increase the number of references further.
