The report by Marine Vogel et al et al describes a rare case of nasopharyngeal carcinoma with rectal metastasis and searched the literature for similar cases. The manuscript is of interest and well written. Minor revision: Page 1, lines 1-3. The sentence on the epidemiology "This tumour has an unbalanced endemic distribution: the incidence... .." should be modified including more details regarding the incidence in endemic and non endemic geographic regions
