Wilson's disease (WD) is an autosomal recessive **disease** involving **brain and liver** secondary to altered copper metabolism. About 47% and 55% of cases reported have positive family history and consanguinity, respectively. The **symptoms** are nonspecific and the **disease** may present as **hepatic disease** or progressive **neurological disorder** (hepatic dysfunction being less apparent or occasionally absent) or as **psychiatric illness with liver disease**.
