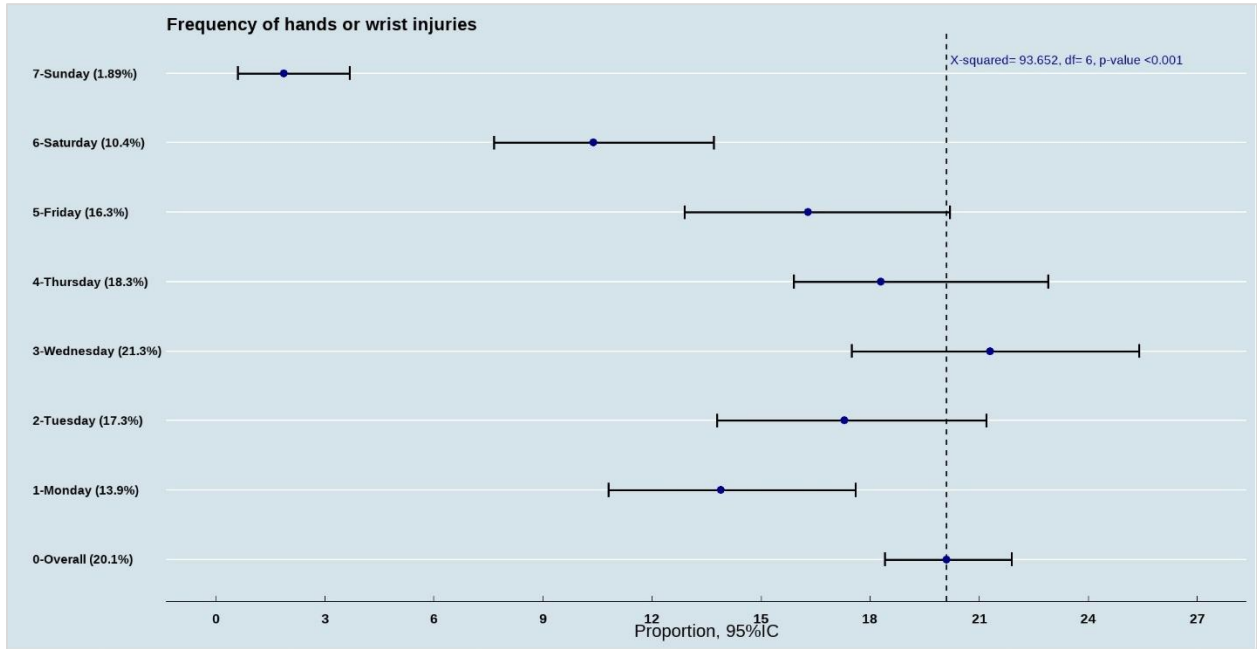

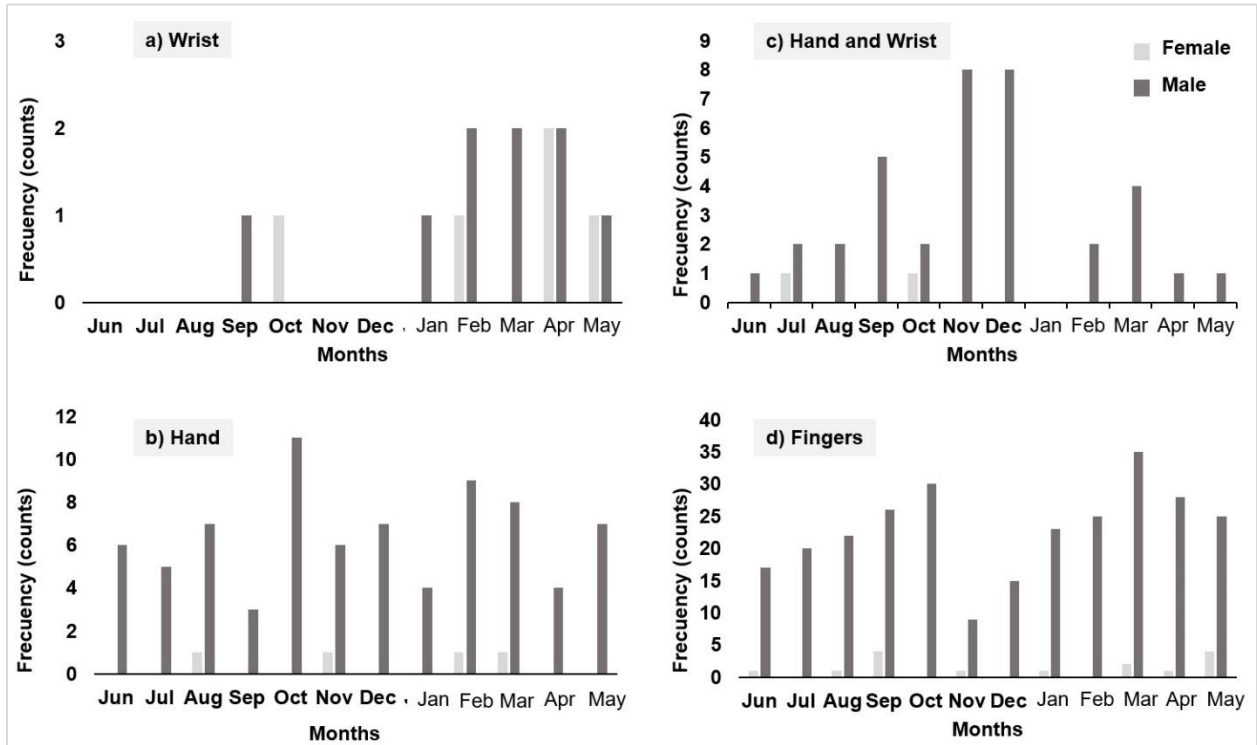
2 **Figure S1.** Distribution of OHWIs by the days of the week.
