However, the preceding part of the sentence is just talking about VEGF expression, so using its utility here implies you are talking about VEGF. Need to modify this sentence if you are talking about bevacizumab In the introduction you probably need to say what bevacizumab is and how it works (ie monoclonal antibody against VEGF)

Case report, line 2: presented (past tense) rather than presents Also presented with a 30-plus year history (not presented with 30-plus year history) Line 5: included, not includes (I would keep everything as past tense)
