Manuscript title: Shedding light on pancreatic metastasis of clear cell sarcoma: an exceptional journey This is a good editorial, which focused on the study conducted by Liu et al. on pancreatic metastatic CCS in the World Journal of Clinical Cases 2024; 12(8):1448-1453. Pancreatic metastasis of clear cell sarcoma (CCS) is extremely rare. In this study, the basic features, pathological and genetic features of CCS are introduced. In addition to contributing to the small body of literature on pancreatic metastases of CCS, authors also highlighted how CCS could invade and manifest in atypical locations like the pancreas, making it difficult for medical professionals to diagnose and treat the condition, and emphasized the constant search for information in the face of uncommon diseases.
