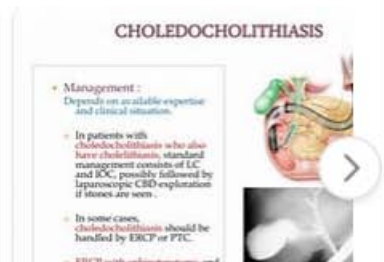
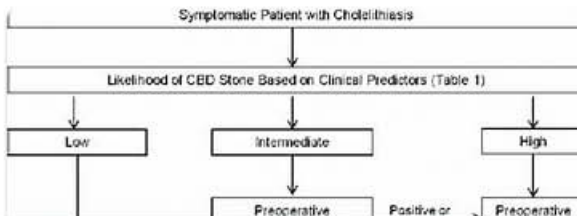

## Choledocholithiasis

Medical Condition

A condition where gallstones obstruct the common bile duct. The bile duct is the small tube that carries bile from the gallbladder to the intestine.

- Rare (Fewer than 200,000 cases per year in US)
- Requires lab test or imaging
- Treatable by a medical professional
- Can last several weeks or months

Stones may be formed due to a high level of cholesterol or bilirubin. Most commonly observed symptoms are jaundice, fever, chills, and pain in right upper quadrant. Treatment options involve surgical procedures.

### Symptoms

The symptoms include:

- Fever
- Pain in the right upper quadrant
- Jaundice
- Nausea and vomiting

### Treatments

Treatment options involve surgical procedures.

#### Self care

- Avoid junk food completely
- Consume nuts which contain unsaturated fats
- Follow a healthy diet
- Cut down on carbohydrates
- Exercise regularly
- Increase the intake of water
