Manuscript ID: 55795 Manuscript Type: Review Manuscript Title: Secondary Causes of Inflammatory Bowel Diseases Comments to the Author: In this manuscript, authors reviewed the literatures describing certain etiological factors that were responsible for development of inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) termed as 'secondary IBD'. They divided them into drug-induced IBD, post-surgical IBD and post-transplant IBD and mentioned it. This manuscript is well written. However, the followings are the minor comments and questions to the authors. Minor comments: 1. In Post-Colectomy Ileal Pouchitis: After the total proctocolectomy for disease other than IBD, such as familial adenomatous polyposis, how frequency did secondary IBD occur? 2. In Fecal Microbiota Transplantation-related IBD: There was much explanation about the efficacy of FMT, but there was little explanation about secondary IBD after treatment with FMT.
