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Figure Title: *Figure 1. The illustration shows the major categories of physical therapies applied in IBS and their representative clinical effects.*

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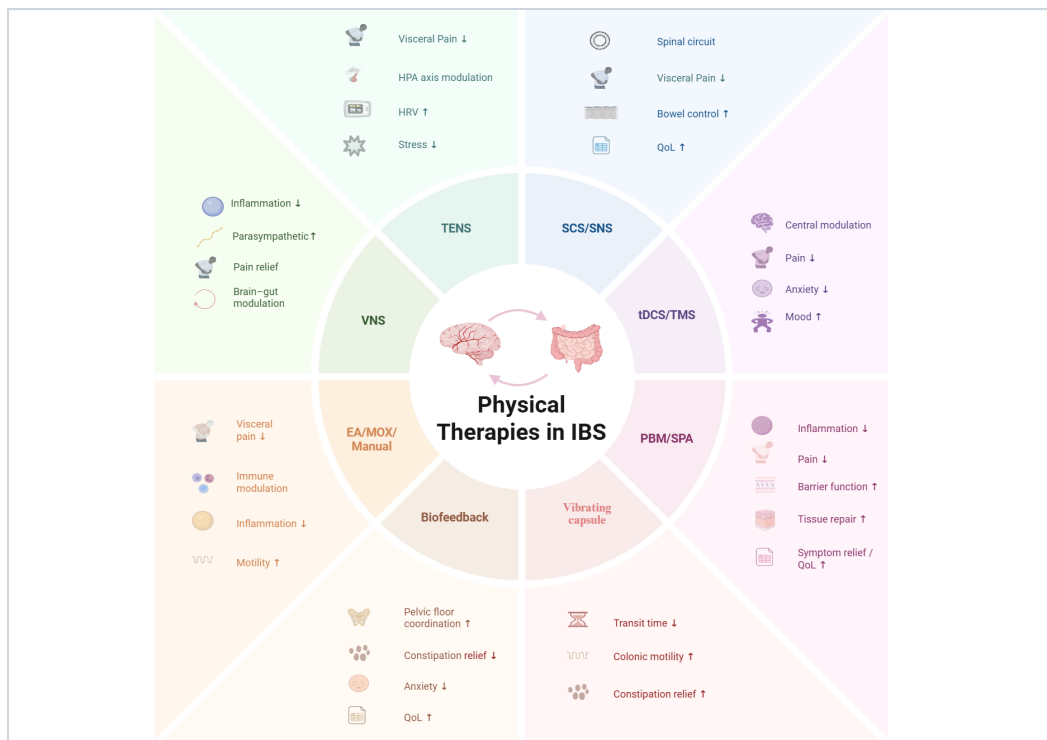
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
