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


**Figure Title:** Clinical risk factors influencing thrombosis in colorectal cancer.



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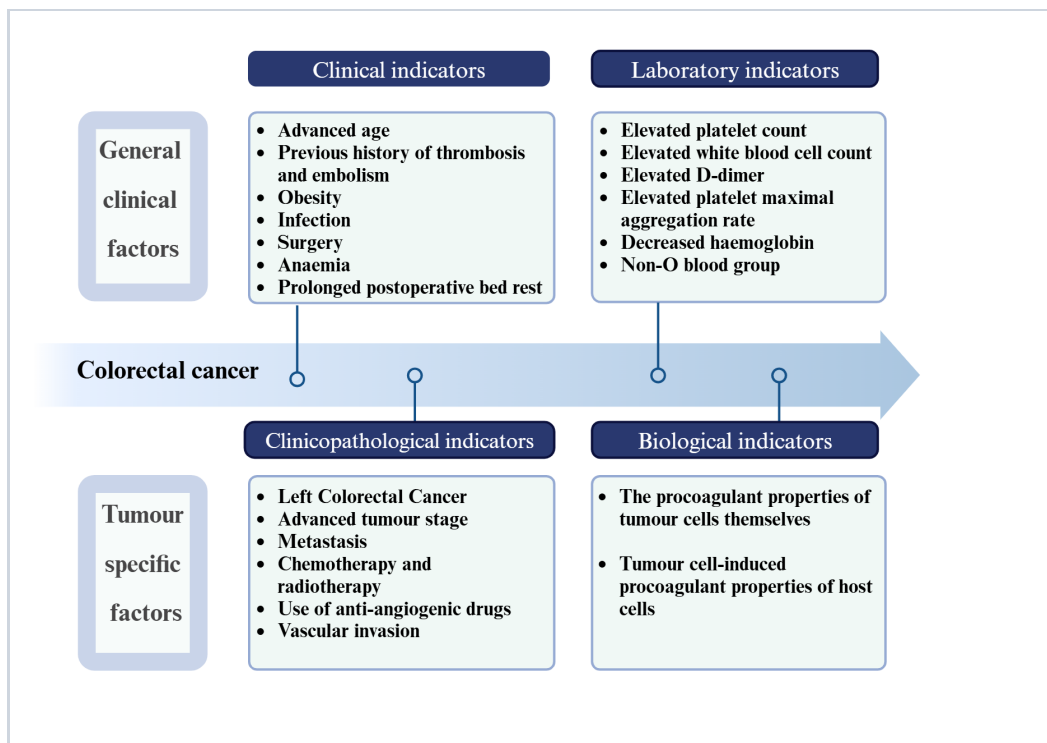

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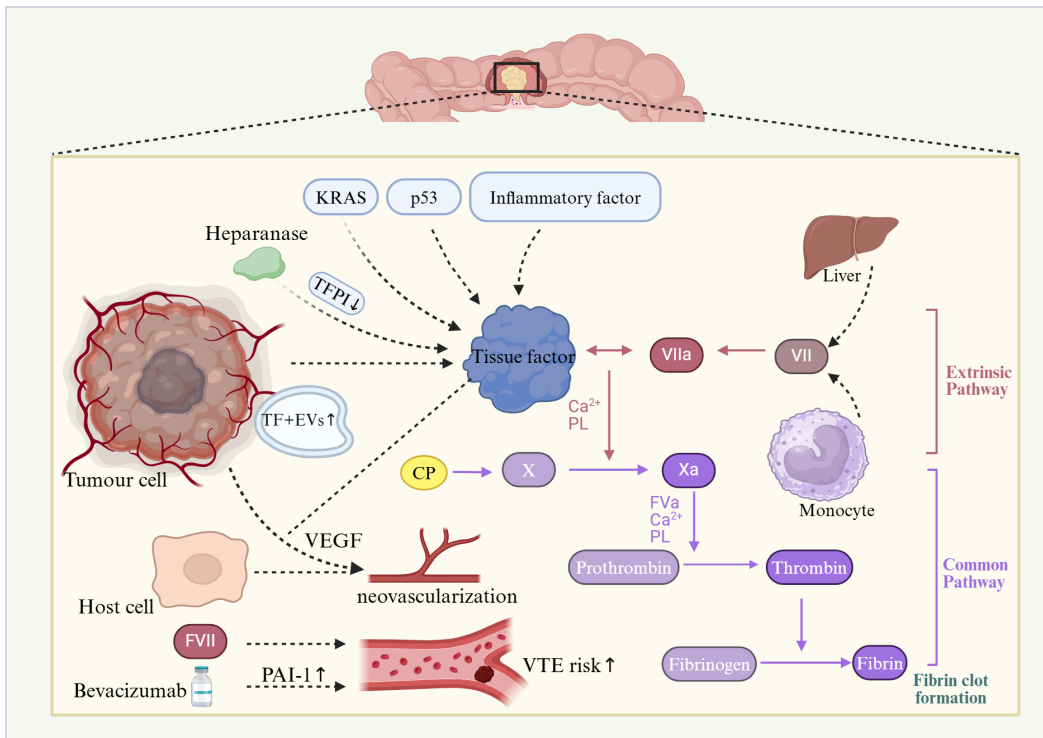

**Figure Title:** Induction of procoagulant phenotype in host cells by colorectal cancer cells: a cascade of cellular interactions.



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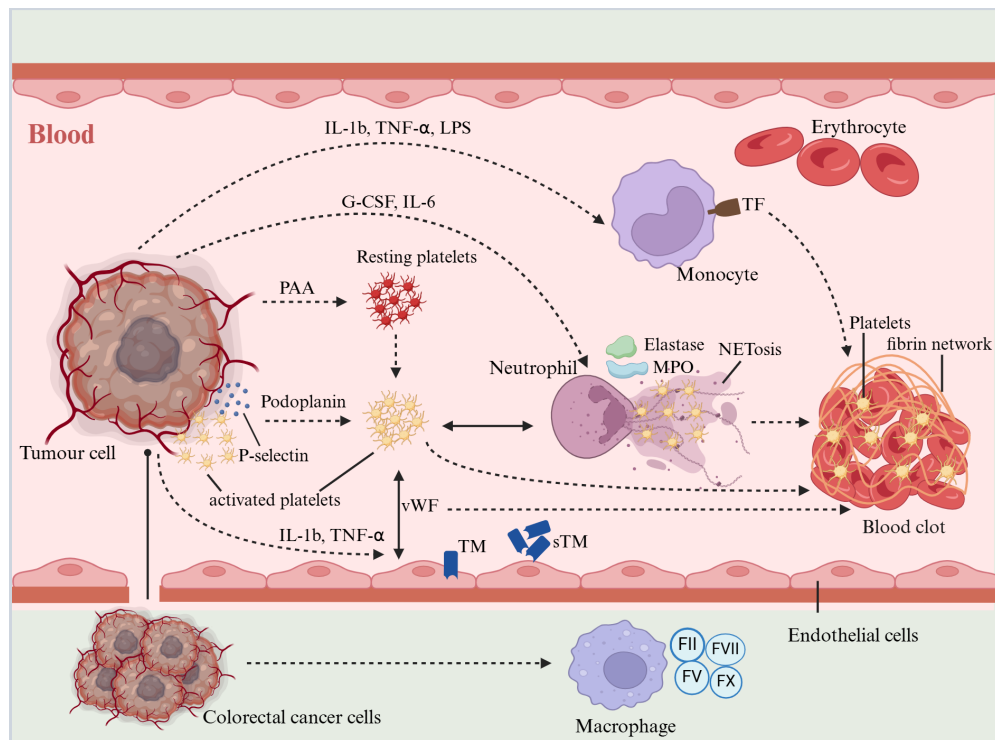

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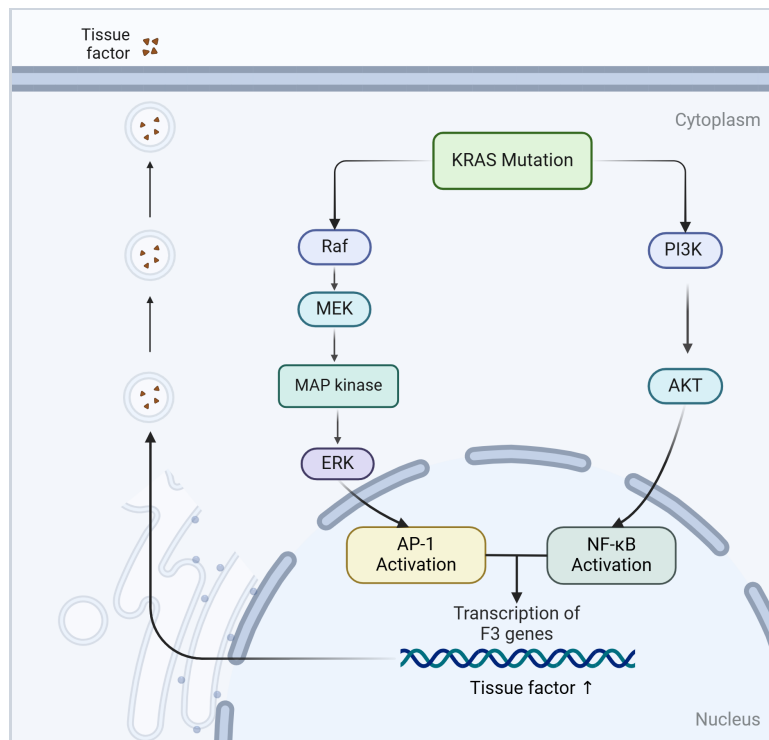
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
