This case is very interesting. As we know, in rare GIST cases, these tumors are found in intra-abdominal sites unrelated to the gastrointestinal tract, such as the mesentery, omentum and retroperitoneum, but pancreatic extra GIST are extremely rare. In this manuscript, Tian et al reported two cases of pancreatic GISTs. The cases are well presented, and the discussion is good. It can be accepted for publication after some minor language correction.
