The manuscript entitled 'Diazoxide toxicity in congenital hyperinsulinism: a seldom-considered rare side effect' is a case report highlighting an adverse effect of a potentially beneficial drug and the crucial and prompt responses taken to safeguard the life of the patient from those adverse effects. The case report is well written, with clear citing of the events of the neonate's life. The authors have very well exposed the development of the adverse effect, and what steps they took to counter it in a very timely manner which helps to grasp the concept of the report more easily. As clear as this case report is, it is lacking any family history of hyperinsulinism/pancreatic insufficiency and more information should be provided over it. It also lacks to submit a follow-up report of the patient on his progress.
