

Supplementary Video 1: Step-by-step endoscopic pancreatography. The main pancreatic duct (MPD) should be cannulate, then a hydrophilic guidewire goes through the MPD and then contrast is injected and the MPD is studied. One should look at any stricture, contrast extravasation or abrupt cut off. After the MPD study, contrast should be aspirated and a pancreatic sphincterotomy towards 1 o'clock followed by a pancreatic plastic stent should be performed.
